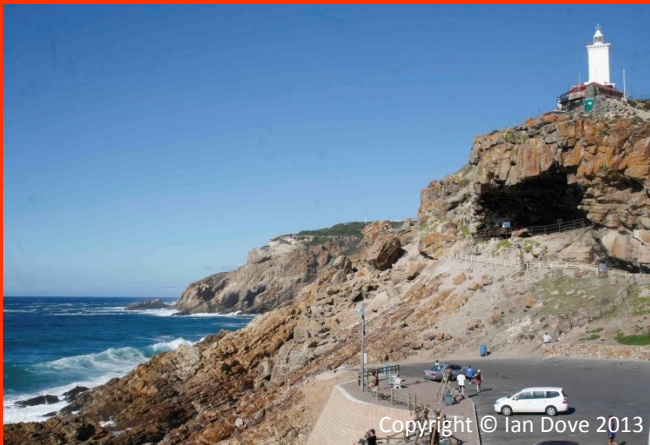

The Garden Route stretches along the Southern Coast of South Africa essentially from Mossel Bay in the West to Storms River in the East. Some contend that the entire coastline from Cape Town to Port Elizabeth is worthy of the title, given to this beautifully scenic and verdant region of South Africa. It is an area of lakes, mountains indigenous forests coral reefs and idyllic beaches. It is also famous for the nearby Cango Caves, and ostrich farms. It is also well known for its many splendid and in some cases unusual golf courses

A 2 night 3 day Lion of Africa garden Route Essentials tour includes:-

Day 1 Cape Town - Mossel Bay via Sir Lowries Pass Houw Hoek Inn , -Bat Cave, The Point , Post office Tree (1st nights Accommodation is usually at the Point Hotel).

Day 2 Oudtshoorn – Safari Ostrich Farm, Cango Caves, Wilderness and Lakes district, Knysna – The Heads Garden of Eden then Plettenberg Bay –Robberg Peninsula Reserve, Storms River Bridge, Tsitsikamma Coastal Reserve, 2nd Nights Accommodation is Usually at Redbourne Lodge Plettenberg Bay

Day 3 Blaauwkrans bridge & Gorge to watch bunji jumping, Tsitsikamma coastal Reserve Storms River Bridge, Finish in Port Elizabeth for return/onward flight.

Optional Extras – Additional days needed. Cape Agulhas, Outeniqua Choo Choo (When Running), C P Nel Museum, Rust & Vrede Waterfall, Swartberg Pass & Die Hel Adventure, Whale/dolphin watching (in season), Keurboom River Cruise, Crocodile Farm, Mini Safari, Craft Shops , Bunji Jumping at Blaauwkrans, Jeffreys Bay & Cape St Frances, Day Tour of Port Elizabeth.
